Environmental Health Intern for Mosquito Surveillance/ Sewage Treatment

Hours: **Temporary -**40 hours per week, 7:00 – 4:00pm M-R and 7:00 – 1:00pm F.

The Darke County Health Department is seeking a Field Worker to work in the Sewage Treatment Systems Operation and Maintenance Program. The Candidate will work to educate homeowners on their sewage treatment system and perform inspections. Primary focus is to protect public health. Candidate must possess excellent communication skills as well as assist in writing enforcement letters.

Other job responsibilities may include: Assisting Sanitarians with inspections, help with public health nuisance complaints, and scrap tire inspections. The intern will also help with the mosquito surveillance and control program. If the Health Department receives an OEPA grant, the candidate may work more on mosquito surveillance program than sewage maintenance.

The Operation & Maintenance Field Worker will work to educate homeowners on their sewage treatment system, perform inspections, and write enforcement letters. Primary focus is to protect public health. A mosquito surveillance intern will work to set and check traps, collect adult mosquitos for shipment or analysis, and educate residents of steps for mosquito abatement.

Candidate must enforce state and local laws, and rules and regulations and participate in public health emergency responses and trainings as needed.

County vehicle may be available for job use. Mileage Reimbursed for Personal Vehicle Use.

Minimum Qualifications:

- A college student studying Environmental Health or related science (Biology, Chemistry, etc.) preferred or a High School Student at least 16 years of age and interested in Environmental Health.
- Must be dependable, organized, and possess excellent communication skills.
- Must be willing to work outside and with homeowners.
- Must be able to read a map and understand safe handling of pesticides.
- Must have a valid Driver's License, transportation and auto insurance.
- Must be able to lift 50 lbs
